NOTICE - STREET CLOSED TO ALL TRAFFIC

Dear Resident or Property/Business Owner:

The City of Thousand Oaks has retained Petrochem Materials Innovation, LLC (PMI) to apply a slurry seal preservation treatment over the existing pavement on YOUR STREET. This work is part of the City's street maintenance program to restore the appearance of the street pavement in your neighborhood while extending its service life and minimizing further deterioration. The project will slurry seal your street in approximately the next week, barring any adverse weather conditions or other unforeseen circumstances.

"Tow-Away/No Parking/No Driving" signs will be posted on your street 48 hours prior to the street closure. Cars parked in the "No Parking" areas will be towed away at the owner's expense if the owner cannot be immediately located. There will be NO STREET ACCESS to or from your home from 7:00 am until 4:00 pm on the day of the street closure in order to prevent damaging the street and private property. Please be advised that slurry sticks to and stains bicycles, cars, clothes, and shoes. Please avoid contact with the material until the street is reopened to traffic.

Please turn off sprinklers and avoid watering during the entire street closure period in order to avoid damaging the finish of your street. Please also postpone any deliveries and notify guests of the street closure.

Sidewalks, where available, will remain open. The project is being staged so parking should be available on an adjacent street. Please plan ahead and allow for additional time due to the construction closure. We do apologize for the inconvenience.

We are committed to working with you to help minimize the impact of construction on your daily activities. Thank you for your patience while we work to improve the streets in the City of Thousand Oaks.
